More than 50 boys are enrolled in the program. They are cared for by staff who are residents of the home, and other daily workers. About half of the boys enrolled in TSC reside on campus full-time. The other half have been resettled with their families.

The boys who live at TSC receive the necessities of education, food, shelter, medical care, spiritual guidance, and more. Those who have returned to their homes receive support from TSC for their education, clothes, food (as needed), medical care, etc. so that they can stay with their families; who do not have financial means to provide these things for them. Without this help, these boy would be back on the streets, because the financial burden would be too much for their families.

Get Involved:
