

## **ADDENDUM TO CEMETERY RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **SOUTH CEMETERY**

Rules and Regulations 1 through 12, except Regulation 10, shall apply to the South Cemetery addition (effective May 4, 1986).

The following additional Rules and Regulations shall also apply to the South Cemetery addition (effective May 4, 1986):

- a. Graves in which an interment has been made may be marked only by a flat tablet or grave marker set flush with the sod. The marker may be a head marker, foot marker, or a combination of the two. The marker may be of bronze, brass, granite or a combination of bronze/brass and granite.
- b. Persons desiring to have head marker, foot marker, or a combination of the two, should check with the Cemetery Committee for details before having work started. Committee will specify:
  1. That the marker does not extend into another plot.
  2. That the concrete base be installed which must be at least 4 inches deep and extend 4 inches on all sides beyond the base of the marker to be installed.
- c. No monumental work, tombstone marker vault, fence memorial, mound or other objects of any kind protruding above the surface of the ground may be erected.
- d. The opening and closing of graves shall be done under the supervision and direction of a representative of the Cemetery Committee.
