Well, actually, coming soon to *this* church. Here's a partial list of events and deadlines to anticipate in the weeks and months ahead:

Wednesday, November 17: Hanging of the Greens, after Open Door supper.

Sunday, November 21, during worship: Pledge cards for the 2021 Stewardship season will be received and dedicated.

Sunday, November 21, immediately after worship: Annual congregational Thanksgiving meal in Brown Fellowship Hall. Meat, dressing, and gravy provided. Bring side dishes and desserts to share. **PLEASE** contact the church office this week to let us know you plan to attend — it makes a difference to those preparing the meal. (It might also matter to a turkey, which can live to “gobble-gobble” another day if we don't need it to feed the crowd.)

Thursday-Friday, Nov. 25-26: Church offices closed for Thanksgiving.

Monday, November 29: Deadline to order poinsettias. Firm deadline.

Saturday, December 11: A Visit with Santa, sponsored by LIFT (Ladies in Fellowship Together). Family-friendly event featuring light refreshments, photo opportunity with Saint Nicholas, all a fundraiser for Christian Education programs.

Sunday, December 12: A service of Lessons & Carols will be presented by a wide array of church musicians. Poinsettias appear in the sanctuary, adding a seasonal grace note to worship.

Sunday, December 19: Youth groups present a Christmas pageant, *Rooty's Christmas Wish*, during worship.

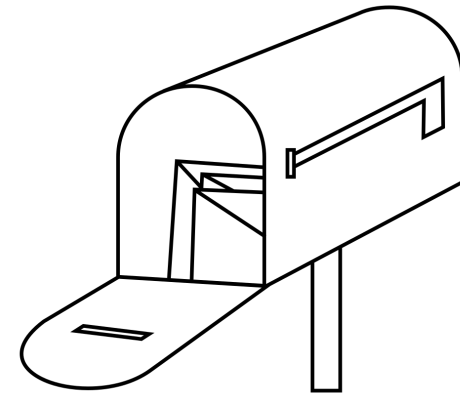
Friday, December 24: Christmas Eve worship service, **7 p.m.**, in the sanctuary.

We typically collect these coins (and dollars, and checks) on the **first Sunday of each month**. Salem Presbytery uses donations from all the churches in its purview to grant monies to groups and institutions that directly address problems of hunger in their local communities.
